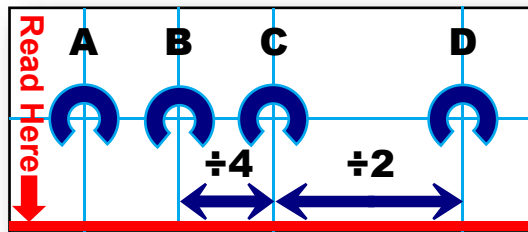

This section is for the cross beam. The marks at A,B,C,D indicate the four pin positions
